As we look back over our years at Xenia High School one may wonder, "How did we ever make it?", but now is not the time for contemplating the past but for planning the future.



### XENIA'S JUNIOR MISS FINALISTS




Girls are judged in many areas but are awarded only in the following: mental alertness, creative and performing arts, youthful fitness, and poise and appearence.


### A F S


### Special


